MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING Town of Oneida, Outagamie County August 13, 2025

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 7:04 P.M. by Al Krause.

Pledge of Allegiance: Led by Al Krause.

Read, correct, and approve the Monthly Town Board Meeting Minutes on July 9, 2025: Terry Hock motioned to approve Monthly Town Board Meeting Minutes from July 9, 2025, without correction. Al Krause seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Read, correct, and approve the Board of Review Meeting Minutes on July 22, 2025: Terry Hock motioned to approve Board of Review Meeting Minutes from July 22, 2025, without correction. Al Krause seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Read, correct, and approve the Cooperative Governmental Agreement Meeting with Oneida Nation Minutes on July 28, 2025: Al Krause motioned to approve Monthly Town Board Meeting Minutes from July 9, 2025, without correction. Terry Hock seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Approval of Vouchers: Al Krause motioned to approve the vouchers numbered 26315 through 26331 and 12 EFT online payments. With VOID 26320 Oshkosh Fire Department due to the Fire Department funding expense. Terry Hock seconded motion. Motion carried.

Outagamie County Sheriff Department- Resident Concerns: Town Board confirmed with the Sheriff's Department that the No Parking on Lambie Rd has gone through the required steps and is enforceable.

The Town Board is actively working with the Fox Valley Humane Association on a solution for handling stray dogs. Oneida Police Department dispatch confirmed that the Oneida Police will assist with stray dogs for tribal members, and the Fox Valley Humane Association confirmed this agreement. The Association is inquiring about the solution for non-tribal members. The Town of Oneida will initiate discussions with the Oneida Police Department to determine a resolution.

Town Recommendation Form- W1763 State Rd 54: Erik Schulstad proposed a Town Recommendation Form for auto repair for undercoating and rust repair/maintenance on vehicles. Auto work would be completed in an existing building on resident's property. Al Krause motioned to approve the Town Recommendation form for W1763 State Rd 54 Seymour, WI 54165 Terry Hock seconded the motion. Motion carried. Erik Schulstad

Assessment Revaluation: Terry Hock motioned to approve Contract Agreement for Consulting, Assessing and Appraisal Services with Borree Appraisal Services for consulting, assessing, and appraisal services for 2026-2030 assessment years with exterior revaluation for the year 2026. Terry Hock seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Fire Department Report: Provided by Glen Olson.

Total calls: 8. On 7/15/2025, Old Seymour Rd; lift assist. On 7/15/2025, Hwy 54; car vs deer. On 7/23/2025, Park Dr; Tree on Wire. On 7/23/2025, Deer Path Dr; Branches on wires. On 7/23/2025, Ranch Rd; Tree across road and wires down. On 8/2/2025, Cty U; Car accident. Driver had passed away. On 8/6/2025, Hwy 29: Car upside down in ditch. No transport. On 8/7/2025, Hwy 55; SUV rollover. 2 transported.

Fire Department Training: Vehicle/tree extraction and search.

Fire Department News: Oneida Nation Elementary for National Night Out with approximately 60kids. Fire Prevention at Oneida Nation Recreational Center with approximately 30 kids. The Fire Department had 2 trucks in the Seymour Hamburger Parade. The new compressor and air packs are now service, and the department sent a thank you to Oneida Nation for their generous funding and support.

First Responder Report: Provided by County Rescue for July 2025; Total calls = 27 Sick Person (7), Fall Victim (5), Chest Pain (2), Overdose/Poisoning (2), Traffic Accident (2), Traumatic Injury (2), Unconscious/Fainting (2), Breathing Problems (1), Heart Problems (1), Stroke/ CVA (1), Vomiting (1). Response Time - 8.64 min.

Open Discussion –Limit 3 minutes per person

Cheryl Van Den Berg thanked the Fire Department for all their volunteer time not only for emergency response but for the additional time they dedicate beyond calls for education and training.

Resident and Board discussion regarding the town maintenance boom mower currently being serviced. Discussion of long-term investment of servicing and maintaining current boom mower vs looking into purchasing new, rent equipment, or hiring service. Many roads in the town and all newly resurfaced roads are built up which creates a steep road ditch. The boom mower is used for those locations where the maintenance mower cannot access. Discussion of current options to assist with certain locations to improve visibility and safety. Resident suggestions for hiring while boom mower is being serviced: Charlie Meltz (town resident), Jon Sobiek (town resident), Oneida Nation (maintenance department), Lucas Vellema (contracted through County Drainage District)

Pat Cornelious asked what the feet of a right-of-way is. The approximate distance is 66 ft of right-of-way; however, it can differ from road to road to depending on the width of the road.
