

MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING

TOWN OF ONEIDA, OUTAGAMIE COUNTY

APRIL 10, 2024

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 P.M. by Scott Schaumberg

Present were: Scott Schaumberg, Al Krause, Terry Hock and Kelly Hill

Also Present: Riley Olson, Jeff Jones, Bruce Neshek, Zack Schrieber, Teresa Schrieber, Marty Schriber, Joseph VanKauwenberg, Ken Olson and Lori Olson,

Scott Schaumberg led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Al Krause made a motion to approve the Monthly Town Board Meeting Minutes from March 13, 2024 without corrections. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried

Al Krause made a motion to approve the Special Town Board Meeting Minutes on April 8, 2024 for accepting of road bids. Road bids for Olson Rd (North Section) 22' x 1,800' from Pearl St to Cooper Rd. Approximately 1.5 miles. Road bids were as follows; Northeast Asphalt \$290,097. MCC \$ 269,991. Outagamie County Highway Department \$349,901. The Town Board approved acceptance of the bid from MCC for Olson Rd (north section) 22' x 8,100'. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried.

Scott Schaumberg made a motion to budget transfer of \$1,700 from Capital Expenses to Auditor/Account. Due to increased fees from the auditor. Town budgeted \$9,000 and the bill was \$10,700. Al Krause second the motion. Motion carried.

Scott Schaumberg made a motion to approve the vouchers numbered 25902 thru 25943 and 9 EFT online payment. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried.

Outagamie County Sheriff Department; Outagamie County Sheriff was present and requested concerns from residents. Scott Schaumberg stated there was a resident concern of the dangerous intersection of County S and County U.

Terry Hock made a motion to approve the following permissions for Oneida Nation;

Approve proposal of Oneida Nation to complete stormwater conveyance modifications within the Town of Oneida road right-of-way at the intersection of Town Road and Amanda Way

Approve the Permission for the Oneida Nation to complete a municipal sewer system installation within the Town of Oneida road right-of-way at in the following locations: Iroquois Drive, Onondaga Drive, Oneida Drive, Sarah Street and Van Boxel Road (*from Oneida Drive to Ranch Road*).

Approve the Permission for the Oneida Nation to work within the Town of Oneida's road right-of-way(s) and undertake an effort to replace the waterway crossing structures (*bridges*) located in the following locations: Old Seymour Road (*west of the intersection with VanBoxtel Road*) and Culbertson Road (*west of the intersection with CTH-H*).

Al Krause second. Motion carried.

BugTussel-. Scott Schaumberg made a motion to approve the Ground Lease Agreement proposed by BugTussel. Al Krause second the motion. Motion carried.

Deer Run Trail. Marty Schrieber, Zach Schriber and Teresa Schriber presented discussion regarding the private drive of Deer Run Trail. Residents are requesting process verification to complete new surveys for surrounding properties of the private drive and include two additional lots. Current private drive does not allow additional lots due to Outagamie County Subdivision ordinance. In order to advance, private drive must be improved to meet all DOT requirements. Discussion of 66 ft of dedicated right-of-way and 22 ft road width. Along with the road improvement, the proposed new survey map would need to be signed by all landowners and dedication of the road to the town. No further action at this time.

Wisconsin Statutes 86.03- Trees on an adjacent to highway (1) Removal of Fallen Trees. Scott Schaumberg announced that due to multiple trees down from the winter storm, the state statute clarifies the responsibility of the land owner to clean up trees that have fallen in the right-of-way.

Pearl St; Scott Schaumberg stated a resident contacted him in regards to the water in the road ditch the address W1248 Pearl St Oneida WI. Scott Schaumberg asked resident to present his concern at the monthly board meeting. Resident is not present. Scott Schaumberg summarized residents concern of the water pooling in the road ditch around W1248 Pearl St. Scott Schaumberg had Ken Olson with Olson Construction take elevation grade of culverts on Pearl St. Elevation report was presented to the Board and residents. Ken Olson stated that the west driveway of W1248 Pearl St is too high. The placement of that culvert may be contributing to the pooling of water in the right of way. Along with that, the surrounding property at the corner of Pearl and Smith was dug out last year and that is not properly to grade and not helping the flow of water. Scott Schaumberg stated that the quarry is properly draining the water to the right of way. Scott stated the road ditches are for water runoff, field drainage, sub pump drainage. The Town cannot and should not stop water from flowing into the proper location.

house. 85,000ppm. 4/3/2024-Storm damage. (7) calls of trees/wires down. 4/8/2024-Cty Rd H; Backhoe unloading hit wires.

Fire Department news given by Riley Olson. March Training; meeting was for First Aid/CPR refresher course. A few firefighters went to Seymour for training for an active shooter situation.

First Responder Report given by County Rescue and reported by Kelly Hill for February 2024; Total calls=17. Advanced Life Support =. Basic Life Support =1. Canceled calls=4 Non-transports =2 (15%). Mutual Aid=0. EMRs on-scene=3.

Open Discussion – Limit 3 minutes per person

Scott Schaumberg asked Ken Olson with Olson Construction to check the status of the culverts on Olson Rd prior to road construction.

Bruce Neshek asked if he could clean up the tall grass around his culvert. Scott Schaumberg replied that any clean up help in the road ditch is helpful to improve the flow of water.

Ken Olson stated that the night arrow on McCabe Rd and Hanson Rd needs replacement.

Ken Olson stated the bridge signs on Culbertson Rd need to be straightened or repaired.

Ken Olson stated there is a surveyor rod sticking up on McCabe Rd.

Kelly Hill stated a resident presented concern in the clerk's office regarding a survey marking sticking up at the intersection of Ranch Rd and Laurmar Rd.

Al Krause made a motion to adjourn at 8:18P.M. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried.
