

MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING
TOWN OF ONEIDA, OUTAGAMIE COUNTY
SEPTEMBER 8, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 P.M. by Scott Schaumberg

Scott Schaumberg led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Al Krause made a motion to approve the minutes without corrections for the Monthly Town Board Meeting on August 11, 2021 and Special Town Board Meeting on August 16, 2021. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried.

Al Krause made a motion to approve the vouchers, numbered 24827 thru 24852 and four EFT online payments. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried.

Outagamie County Sheriff Department – No Deputy was able to attend the meeting this month.

Discuss Town Hall flooring and painting of cabinets quotes – Scott Schaumberg informed the Town Residents that he lost the quote for painting cabinets and said we will have to table that part until next month. Jennifer Andersen gave the Town Board the quotes from Macco's Commercial Interiors, H.J. Martin and Sons and Commercial Flooring Contractors (CFC). Town Board reviewed all bids. Scott Schaumberg made a motion to approve H.J. Martin and Sons quote. Al Krause second the motion. Al Krause also made a motion to approve the paint quote for cabinets since the quote was here last month and the price was very reasonable. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried.

Fire Department Report – Fire Chief Glen Olson stated they had 4 calls in August; 1 CO call, 1 false alarm, 1 microwave call and 1 single car accident with thermo imaging. Training last month was hose testing.

First Responder Report – No First Responder available and Jennifer did not receive a report from County Rescue to report.

Open Discussion – Limit 3 minutes per person – Scott Schaumberg asked if anyone had anything. Barb asked about the "V-shape" on Old Seymour Road. Scott said it was getting worse, just like Vine Road.
