

MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING  
TOWN OF ONEIDA, OUTAGAMIE COUNTY  
JUNE 9, 2021

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The meeting was called to order at 7:04 P.M. by Scott Schaumberg

Terry Hock made a motion to approve the minutes without corrections for the Monthly Town Board Meeting on May 12, 2021. Al Krause second the motion. Motion carried.

Al Krause made a motion to approve the vouchers, numbered 24746 thru 24772 and four EFT online payments. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried.

Outagamie County Sheriff Department – No Deputy was able to attend the meeting this month.

Rezoning Request – Shaun Clarmont – Scott Schaumberg explained to the Residents that were at the meeting, he had a meeting with Outagamie County and Shaun Clarmont about the rezoning issue earlier and asked if Shaun would explain what he would like to do with his property. Shaun Clarmont explained that his property is on Service Road and it is zoned Industrial and would like it to be rezoned Commercial, so his tenants that rent it out could sell out of it. Scott said he wasn't sure why it wasn't zoned Commercial to begin with, since it was a grocery store many years ago. Scott asked Jennifer if she knew, and Jennifer stated she did not. That would be have been a question for Outagamie County or should have been asked before the meeting so she could have done some research.

Al Krause made a motion to approve the request to rezone from Industrial to Commercial. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried.

Liquor License – Oneida Nation; One Stop E & EE, Steven Krabbe; Krabbe's Kountry Klub, Inc., Brenda Danforth; Brenda's Country Bar – Scott Schaumberg made a motion to approve the liquor licenses for the year. Al Krause second the motion. Motion carried.

ATV/UTV Discussion on Town Roads – Tabled from May's Monthly Town Meeting - Scott Schaumberg said he called the Chairman from the Town of Cicero and discussed the ordinance they put into effect, which helped answer questions he had. Scott asked the Residents that were at the meeting if anyone had any concerns, questions or comments. JoAnn Hebert asked

if they pass this ordinance in the Town are there going to be speed limits set? Scott stated yes, 35mph. She then asked if we are traveling down a highway at 55mph in a non-passing zone, are vehicles allowed to pass? Scott stated they are not allowed on any county or highways. Only town roads.

Sharon VandenHeuvel said she is worried about more accidents, they just had one north of here.

Scott Schaumberg made a motion to proceed with planning of the ATV/UTV in the Town of Oneida. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried.

Fire Department Report – Fire Chief Glen Olson stated they had 8 calls in May; 2 calls for wires down, 3 MABAS with Seymour, 1 lift assist, 1 car rollover and 1 control burn. Pumper training in May was done.

In June Glen stated they had 5 calls; 2 two-vehicle accident, 1 MABAS with Hobart, 1 fire alarm and 1 vehicle accident. June's training was with airbags.

Picnic was a good turnout. Glen would like to thank everyone who helped out, fireman, friends, neighbors, relation. All a big help, turned out really good so THANK YOU!

First Responder Report – Kurt Nackers stated they had 17 calls in April. County Rescue sent out postcards to Residents. He understands everyone has full-time jobs but the Town could use First Responders, so anyone interested can contact himself, County Rescue or Jen.

In May they had a total of 27 calls.

Open Discussion – Limit 3 minutes per person – Scott Schaumberg asked if anyone had anything. No one had any questions or comments. Jennifer Andersen said she talked to Dean Steingraber from Outagamie County Highway Department and he informed her that County H will be redone in 2023 no matter what.
