

MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING  
TOWN OF ONEIDA, OUTAGAMIE COUNTY  
JANUARY 12, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 P.M. by Scott Schaumberg

Scott Schaumberg led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Al Krause made a motion to approve the Monthly Town Board Meeting on December 8, 2021 minutes without corrections. Scott Schaumberg second the motion. Motion carried.

Al Krause made motion to transfer \$450 from Capital Expense to Election. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried.

Scott Schaumberg made a motion to approve the vouchers, numbered 24945 thru 25015 and 1 EFT online payment. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried.

Outagamie County Sheriff Department asked if there were any concerns in the town. Sheriff discussed the current county wide traffic grant which included OWI & seat belt monitoring. Scott Schaumberg asked if there was a complaint regarding the holiday light display on Alpine Dr. Officer stated he didn't hear any complaints. Al Krause stated that Fish Creek Rd had previous concern with inattentive driving and possible future concern on that road. Officer stated he would document it. Officer gave Town of Oneida a business card for Lieutenant Wang Lee as a contact.

Storage Unit: No one was present to discuss EE and U storage unit.

Air packs for Fire Department: Scott Schaumberg TABLED topic until we hear back from grants to decide how to pay for the Air packs. Glen stated that he hasn't heard from Oneida Nation regarding grants. The grant is for Town of Oneida and Town of Hobart- Postponed to end of January.

2021 Budget Transfer. Town Board went over budget and transferred funds as follows: Town Board \$4,007.83 will transfer to Capital Expense. Attorney \$2,850.00 will transfer to Capital Expense. Clerk/Treasurer \$1,807.35 will stay. Elections \$0. Auditor \$0. Fire Dept. Building \$16,453.66 will stay. Insurance & Bonds \$50.00 will stay. Fire Department \$53,273.76 will stay. First Responders \$2,004.50 will stay. Building Inspector \$527.00 will transfer to Capital Expense. Rescue squad \$1,065.86 will transfer to Capital Expense. Park \$3,340.58 will stay. Park Fee \$4,511.87 will stay. Hwy Construction and Maintenance \$3,1767.96 will stay. Town Hall \$525.77 will stay. New Addresses \$91.98 will transfer to Capital Expense. Service Award Pension \$3,280.00 will transfer to Capital Expense. 2% Fire Insurance Dues \$12,013.85 will stay. Capital Expenses \$360,230.83 will stay.

Scott Schaumberg made a motion to transfer 2021 Budget Expenditures to 2022 budget. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried.

Fire Department Report given by Fire Chief Glen Olson

6 calls; 1 lift assist on County E with one person transferred. 1 accident on Ranch Rd and 55 due to fog with no lift. 1 Car/deer call on Hwy 55 and Ray Rd with fluid spill. 1 call to assist with Seymour at Performance Pallet. 1 vehicle fire on Fish Creek Rd. 1 lift assist on Old Seymour Rd with 1 transport.

Fire Department had meeting on 1/10/2022 with Oneida Nation regarding Fire Plan and requested evacuation plans. Present in the meeting was; Troy and Tonya representing Oneida Nation, Town of Oneida Fire Department was represented Scott Schaumberg, Terry Hock, Glen Olson and Joe Maass.

Two new firefighter candidates were voted on by Fire Department. On 1/11/2022, Four fire fighters started Fire Officer 1 Course in Seymour, as required by the SP330 ruling.

1/17/2022 is scheduled for training for CPR and First Aide refresher course, done every 2 years.

First Responder Report – No First Responder available and Kelly Hill did not receive a report from County Rescue to report.

Open Discussion – Limit 3 minutes per person

Mike Andraschke presented completed survey of Shirley Vandanelzen, located on south side of EE and west of county line U. 3 parcels. Configure so all buildings are on one parcel other 2 parcels will not have buildings on it. Each lot does have access driveway.

Road Repair; Glen Olson stated that last year Cooper Rd was sealed, however, at the end of the Cooper Rd and Cty Rd U there is a dip that needs repair. Glen also stated that on Vans Ct there is in need of a repair by culvert. Terry Hock presented the need for repair on Tip Rd. BJ O'Connor-Schevers presented the need for Old Seymour Rd to be repaired due to rut in the road.

Mel Vandenberg asked if Oneida Nation will be paying for snowplowing, road repair or fire protection. Scott Schaumberg stated that the Oneida Nation did give us money for general expenses. Per Scott Schaumberg the board does have future meeting with Oneida regarding Service Agreement which includes roads. Mary Olson stated that as a township Town of Oneida must provide fire and ambulance to all as a state law.

Al Krause made a motion to adjourn at 7:54P.M. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried.
