

MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING  
TOWN OF ONEIDA, OUTAGAMIE COUNTY  
FENRARUY 9, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Al Krause

Present were: Al Krause, Terry Hock and Kelly Hill

Al Krause led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Al Krause made a motion to approve the Monthly Town Board Meeting Minutes from January 12, 2022 without corrections. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried.

Terry Hock made a motion to approve the vouchers, numbered 25015 thru 25056 and 2 EFT online payment. Al Krause second the motion. Motion carried.

Outagamie County Sheriff Department; Sheriff stated there has been some increase reports of storage unit burglaries in the area. It has been noted that the locks are getting changed at night and then the burglaries are happening during the day. Sheriff is asking to please report any suspicious activity.

East Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission Resolution; Board members reviewed resolution. Terry Hock made motion to approve the resolution. Al Krause second the motion. Motion carried.

Air packs for Fire Department; Glen Olson stated that the previous grant writer from Oneida Nation is no longer writing for Oneida nation and they are in the process of training a new grant writer. Glen Olson priced air packs with two different companies. He will be receiving a demo air pack in March. The Fire Department currently has 14 packs and would cut back to 12 air packs. Glen Olson is also working with a compressor company for the new air packs. Terry Hock TABLED topic until we hear back from grants to decide how to pay for new air packs.

Fire Department Report given by Fire Chief Glen Olson. 2 calls; CO2 call on County J. Faulty detector. 1 MABAS call with Seymour Rural for barn fire. Engine, 2 tenders, 14 fire fighters responded. The Fire Department had a training meeting on 1-17-2022 for CPR Refresher course. Within the course they practiced situational heart attack response and firefighter down response. March will be First Aid refresher training. On 1-21-2022, Glen Olson and Joe Maass attended the MABAS Meeting in Hortonville. On 1-27-2022, Glen Olson and Joe Maass attended the Outagamie County Fire Chiefs Association Meeting in Grand Chute. ON 2-5-2022, five Oneida Fire Fighters went to a 4 hour RIT Training wit Seymour City, Seymour Rural, Nicholas Fire and Black Creek Fire.

First Responder Report given by County Rescue and reported by Kelly Hill; Total calls=25. Advanced life support = 14. Basic Life Support = 6. Non-transport = 5(20%). Mutual Aid = 0. New first responder in the Town of Oneida who is a Town of Oneida resident. He did assist in 2 calls. 2 more residents are taking classes in February.

Open Discussion – Limit 3 minutes per person

Ken Olson discussed a concern for the urgency to bid road work. According to what he is seeing black top scheduling is filling up.

Mary Olson stated that a previous Town of Oneida Chairman, Norman Austin, passed away.

Terry Hock made a motion to adjourn at 7:14P.M. Al Krause second the motion. Motion carried.
