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The meeting was called to order at 7:30 P.M. by Scott Schaumberg

Present were: Scott Schaumberg, Al Krause, Terry Hock and Jennifer Andersen

Also Present: Lee Nelson, Jason Pausma (Outagamie County, Senior Planner Development and Land Services), BJ OConnor-Schevers, Daniel Garvey, Glen Olson, Kurt Nackers, Tana Aguirre, Melinda Danforth and Dale Smurawa

Al Krause made a motion to approve the minutes without corrections for the Monthly Town Board Meeting on June 14, 2021. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried.

Terry Hock made a motion to approve the vouchers, numbered 24773 thru 24804 and four EFT online payments. Al Krause second the motion. Motion carried.

Outagamie County Sheriff Department – No Deputy was able to attend the meeting this month.

Immaculate Conception Church – Veteran’s Grave Reimbursement – Scott Schaumberg asked if there was anyone here from the church to represent and Jennifer Andersen said no. Jennifer gave the paperwork she received to the Town Board for their review. She stated that she did look through last year’s information and it looks accurate.

Scott Schaumberg made a motion to approve. Al Krause second the motion. Motion carried.

Fire Department Report – Fire Chief Glen Olson stated they had 6 calls in June; 1 arc wire, 1 2-vehicle accident, 1 smoke in apartment, 1 tree and wire on road, 1 car and deer accident and 1 fire alarm due to construction. Search and Rescue was done for training.

First Responder Report – Kurt Nackers stated they had 27 calls. County Rescue held a meeting and no one from the Town of Oneida was in attendance. Melinda Danforth asked if there was any PDF that could be sent to her and she would work to put it on Facebook or on their website to see if there would be any applicants.

Open Discussion – Limit 3 minutes per person – Scott Schaumberg asked if anyone had anything. Melinda Danforth said that Oneida Nation is deciding whether or not to put signs up on their roads for ATV/UTV.

She also wanted to ask the Town Board to reconsider the rezoning of Shaun Clarmont. The Oneida One Stop on Highway 54 does not sell alcohol because it is so close to the schools. Shaun was selling Delta 8 products at his distillery. He was supposed to be a pizza/sub shop. Melinda feels he will not be complaint. Outagamie County Zoning Committee put on hold until the 27<sup>th</sup> of this month. Scott Schaumberg stated that at this time he is not going to change anything, he was told by Shaun the tenants he had renting there are no longer there.

Al Krause made a motion to adjourn at 8:15 P.M. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried.
