Al Krause made a motion to approve the vouchers numbered 25944 thru 25966 and 7 EFT online payments. Terry Hock second the motion. Motion carried.

Outagamie County Sheriff Department; No Outagamie County Sheriff present.

Fire Department Report given by Riley Olson. (7 calls) 4/11/2024 SandHill Circle; CO2 call. Faulty Detector. 4/18/2024 Service Rd; Call in for man hanging from tower. Ended up being the tower just being serviced. 4/19/2024 Hillside Dr; House fire. Dishwasher started on fire. 4/23/2024 Oneida Nation High School; Smoke alarm went off due to power outage. Canceled call. Then exhaust fan burnt and were able to put out the fire themselves. 4/24/2024 Vans Rd & Cty J; Car ran in ditch. No transport. 4/25/2024 Legacy La; House fire. Fire started in the garbage can that was in the kitchen. 4/30/2024 Wolf Dr; Wire down on dump truck.

Fire Department news given by Riley Olson. April Training; Annual driving course and every firefighter had to operate both engines. Town of Oneida Volunteer Fire Department Annual Picnic is Sunday, June 2, 2024. Hope to see you all there.

First Responder Report given by County Rescue and reported by Kelly Hill for March 2024; Total calls= 27. Advanced Life Support =17. Basic Life Support =5. Canceled calls=2. Non-transport =6 (22%). Mutual Aid=0. EMRs on-scene=3.

Open Discussion – Limit 3 minutes per person

Scott Schaumberg asked Riley Olson what the status of the Kenworth plow truck is. Riley stated the truck is back and working. Wisconsin Kenworth replaced both the ignition box systems.

Scott Schaumberg asked if there was a start date for the Olson Rd project. Kelly Hill contacted MMC today and requested an update. The Town of Oneida will haul gravel from the quarry on Pearl St.

Cheryl Van Den Berg asked if anyone knows why the Johnson Rd sign keeps getting stolen lately. Riley Olson states the town put the stop sign only on the post and will replace Johnson Rd sign in the future.

Craig Beyer asked what the internet or fiber optic status was in the town. Scott Schaumberg updated the current installation of BugTussle in the Town and potential future projects of BugTussle and Spectrum. Al Krause recommended contacting Star Communications or Bertram. Both of those companies have satellites on area silos and may be an option. Kelly Hill provided Craig Beyer with the contact to BugTussle.

Patricia Cornelius thanked the maintenance for the patching that was completed on Tip Rd.

Patricia Cornelius states she is on the Oneida Land Commission and she asked if they contribute money to the fire department. Riley Olson stated there was a contribution from Oneida Nation when the fire department purchased a fire truck and installed the generator at the fire station a few years back.

Cheryl Van Den Berg suggested the Town put a request into Oneida Nation for support funds for the fire department.

Scott Schaumberg stated the Town of Oneida does meet with Oneida Nation representatives four times a year to discuss various items with the Cooperative Governance Agreement between the Town and Oneida Nation.

Terry Hock made a motion to adjourn at 7:30 P.M. Al Krause second the motion. Motion carried.
