

MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING
Town of Oneida, Outagamie County
February 11, 2026

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Scott Schaumberg.

Present were: Scott Schaumberg, Al Krause, Terry Hock and Kelly Hill
Also Present: Riley Olson, Glen Olson, Ken Olson and Lori Olson

Pledge of Allegiance: Led by Chairperson Scott Schaumberg.

Read, correct, and approve the Monthly Town Board Meeting Minutes on January 14, 2026: Al Krause motioned to approve Monthly Town Board Meeting Minutes from January 14, 2026, without correction. Terry Hock seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Approval of Vouchers: Terry Hock motioned to approve the vouchers numbered 26411 through 26439 and 12 EFT online payments. Al Krause seconded motion. Motion carried.

Town Maintenance provided quote from Wisconsin Kenworth for 2010 Kenworth plow truck. Service total is \$16,092.18 which included the following findings: Exhaust manifold leaking, oil cooler housing leaking then flushing system, A/C compressor leaking freon and oil, coolant return manifold tube leaking and valve train housing leaking.

Outagamie County Sheriff Department- Resident Concerns: No sheriff was present. No resident concerns discussed.

Transfer of unexpended 2025 budget funds: Terry Hock made a motion to transfer \$3000 of the 2025 unexpended Attorney Budget to the 2026 Capital Expense Budget. Al Krause second the motion. Motion carried.

Fire Department Report: Provided and reported by Glen Olson; (4 calls) On 1/22, HWY 22; Car hit power pole. No transport. On 1/23, HWY C; Semi-truck on fire near a building. On 2/3, Seminary Rd; Car hit a tree. No transport. On 2/10, Red Willow Park Way; CO2 call. False alarm due to an alarm clock going off, not a CO2 alarm. January Meeting the Fire Department completed an inventory on all of the trucks. Fire Department News: The Fire Department obtained a comparable price for a fire truck anticipated to be purchased in approximately five years. The comparable truck was ordered from Sister Bay in 2022. The current estimated cost of a similar truck would be approximately \$900,000. The estimated build time is 24–30 months. Payment terms

would be 50% due upon completion of the chassis and the remaining 50% due at completion. Glen Olson provided specifications for the comparable truck.

First Responder Report: No report provided by County Rescue.

Open Discussion – Limit 3 minutes per person.

Chairperson Scott Schaumberg asked the Clerk for an update regarding the CGA Agreement with the Oneida Nation related to information sharing and a request from the Oneida Nation concerning Oneida Nation owned properties that are surveyed to the centerline of certain town roads.

The Clerk reported that she clarified this matter with the Town Assessor, who stated that it is common for some surveys to extend to the center of the road while others extend only to the right-of-way line. In order to locate these properties, they would have to be individually searched and verified along with deed language regarding the easement or highway right-of-way is included.

At this time, Oneida Nation is requesting dedication of Town Road, Government Road, and Fish Creek Road due to potential parcels where the survey extends to the midline of the town road. The Town of Oneida currently issues right-of-way permits for these roads. The Oneida Nation has indicated that their Land Department would need to be involved due to their land use laws.

The Town of Oneida and the Oneida Nation have a meeting scheduled for February 16, 2026, at which time the Town will request additional details and clarification.

Melinda Danforth with Oneida Nation was not present for the meeting and requested if any discussion or request be forwarded to her if indicated.

Adjournment: Al Krause motioned to adjourn at 7:44 P.M. Terry Hock seconded the motion. Motion carried.
