

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-02

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING REGULATION OF THE STORAGE, DISPOSAL,
TRANSPORTATION AND TREATMENT OF SOLID WASTE WITHIN THE
TOWN OF ONEIDA, OUTAGAMIE COUNTY, AND PROVIDING FOR THE
COLLECTION OF RECYCLING AND MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE
WITHIN THE TOWN.

The Town Board, of the Town of Oneida, Outagamie County, enacted Ordinance No. 2020-02 on May 8, 2020 (the "Ordinance").

Article I of the Ordinance regulates, applies to and governs all persons or locations engaged in or encompassing the transportation, disposal, storage and treatment of solid waste in the Town of Oneida ("Town"), including upon Town roads. Such transportation, disposal, storage or treatment shall be permitted only under the terms and conditions set-forth in Article I. The articles exempts the transportation, disposal, storage or treatment of: (1) animal waste resulting from an agricultural enterprise located within the Town; (2) solid or hazardous waste facilities within the Town that are or were licensed by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and were in operation on the date of adoption of Article I; and (3) sanitary privies, seepage beds, septic tanks, waste water, waste water treatment sludge and the disposal and transportation of human waste products in the Town. Article I contains procedures for obtaining a license to establish a solid waste facility or hazardous waste facility within the Town as well as fees, financial surety requirements, and forfeitures.

Article II regulates the accumulation, separation, and disposal of solid waste within the Town and promotes recycling, composting and resource recovery through the administration of an effective recycling program as provided under Wisconsin law. The Ordinance provides requirements for solid waste collection from Town residents, and sets forth the responsibilities of residential unit owners and occupants with respect to solid waste collection and disposal, along with collection and disposal of recyclable materials. The article provides a mechanism for the collection of fees associated with the collection and disposal of solid waste and recyclable materials as well as forfeitures for enforcement of the Ordinance against those who violate the regulations.

Pursuant to Article III, the Ordinance will become effective upon passage by the Town Board and publication as required by the law.
