

MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING
Town of Oneida, Outagamie County
March 11, 2026

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Scott Schaumberg.

Present were: Scott Schaumberg, Al Krause, Terry Hock and Kelly Hill

Also Present: Cheryl Van Den Berg, Ken Olson, Lori Olson, Carl Schaumberg, Glen Olson, and Barb OConnor Schevers.

Pledge of Allegiance: Led by Chairperson Scott Schaumberg.

Read, correct, and approve Meeting Minutes: Terry Hock motioned to approve the Monthly Town Board Meeting Minutes on February 11, 2026. Al Krause seconded the motion. Motion carried; Al Krause motioned to approve the Cooperative Governmental Agreement Meeting Minutes on February 16, 2026. Terry Hock seconded the motion. Motion carried; Al Krause motioned to approve the Road Project Meeting with the Oneida Nation on February 16, 2026. Terry Hock seconded the motion. Motion carried; Al Krause motioned to approve Road Project Meeting with Oneida Nation and Outagamie County Highway Representatives on March 9, 2026. Terry Hock seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Approval of Vouchers: Terry Hock motioned to approve the vouchers numbered 26440 through 26459 and 12 EFT online payments. Al Krause seconded the motion. Motion carried. Scott Schaumberg reminded maintenance to turn in all receipts to the clerk.

Outagamie County Sheriff Department- Resident Concerns: Outagamie County Deputy was present and reported no current concerns. No resident concerns were noted.

Appraisal Revaluation - W320 County Rd S: Residents provided dated photos to the assessor indicating the new home was not completed as of January 1, 2026. Assessor completed the home assessment as of 70% and adjusted the tax evaluation accordingly. Reimbursement to resident is \$1,488.47. Scott Schaumberg motioned to approve the appraisal revaluation of W320 County Rd. Terry Hock the second the motion. Motion carried.

Fire Department Report: Provided by Glen Olson; (3 calls) Cty Rd E; House lockout. Oneida Nation High School; Smoke Alarm in the kitchen burnt food. Onondaga Dr; Lift Assist.

February Training: Annual Pumper operations and driving course with fire trucks.

Calls Included: 5 Sick Persons. 4 Breathing Problems. 3 Chest Pain. 3 Fall Victim. 3 Traffic Accidents. 2 Allergies. 2 Hemorrhage/Laceration. 1 Back Pain. 1 Diabetic Problem. 1 Fire. 1 Heart Problem. 1 Medical Alarm. 1 Psychiatric Problem.

CPR and First Aid is scheduled for 3/16 from 6:00pm-10:00pm. Any resident is welcome to attend.

The Board discussed driveway impacts related to the upcoming road project. It was noted that any concrete driveway extending into the public right-of-way will be removed to the right-of-way line and replaced with asphalt. This is consistent with Town requirements, which state that driveway aprons located within the right-of-way shall not be constructed of concrete.

Representative of the New London ATV Club, Carl Schaumberg, presented information regarding the potential opening of county roads within the Town of Oneida for ATV/UTV use. With support from the Town, the club would initiate the process with the Outagamie County Highway Department.

The club also expressed willingness to provide financial assistance and update existing signage within the Town to align with current ordinance language, which states that ATV/UTV operators shall observe the posted speed limits on all designated Town roads.

The Town Board expressed support for the club to proceed with the process of working with Outagamie County to open county roads within the Town and to coordinate updates to signage.

Road maintenance requesting attention:

VanBoxtel Rd - Shoulder repair

Alpine Rd, Hillside Rd, Crook Rd - Pot Holes

Ray Rd - Reevaluate curve mowed/brush cutting. Safety concern

Evaluate and monitor VanBoxtel Rd, where a recent water main project was completed for possible road repair.

Adjournment: Scott Schaumberg motioned to adjourn at 7:56 P.M. Al Krause seconded the motion. Motion carried.
